

Phase 2.3

In Person

All staff and students in the building

Teaching and learning takes place in school buildings with basic and/or extensive health changes and accommodations to provide for a safe learning environment.

Building at 100% capacity

Phase 4

Hybrid

Learning in school and at home

Students will learn in the building two/three days. Days when students are not in the building they will do remote learning from the home. Building open for 50% capacity

Phase 5

Learning done at home

Students will receive instruction and complete coursework while at home. Times spent on coursework at home will be the same as if they were at school. No students allowed in buildings



Phase 2.3

All students

Learning takes place in the building with basic health and safety accommodations No school or classroom visitors

Transportation

- Assigned seats on all routes
- Hand sanitizer will be used when getting on/off each bus route
- Masks mandatory for drivers and passengers
- Windows will be open (weather permitting)
- Buses sanitized after each route
- LImited shuttle service

Food Service

- More or split lunch periods
- Students will be assigned a table with social distancing
- <u>Plastic silverware will be used</u>
- Reduced meal options available

Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)

- Face mask/covering required for all students and staff (exemptions require a note from a doctor) Masks recommended
- Frequent mask breaks (initially)

Health and Hygiene

- Assigned entry points to the buildings
- Temperature checks on everyone entering buildings (Stopped for students after October BOE meeting)
- Water fountains turned off. Bottle filling stations available
- Hand washing/hand sanitizing every hour
- Desks wiped down when students leave the classroom



Phase 2.3 (cont)

Classroom/Instruction

- Students will sit in assigned seats
- Stable work groups will be utilized
- Individual classroom supplies (no sharing)
- Students socially distanced (whenever possible)
- No large assemblies/groupings
- All extra/non-essential furniture removed from each classroom
- Classroom doors will remain open to minimize touching
- Daily logs required for remote learning (no longer required from KSDE)

Extra and Co-curricular

- Extra-curricular activities will follow KSHSAA guidelines
- Limited spectator attendance (or social distancing required)
- Limited field trips
- Choir/Band classes will socially distance in larger classrooms (gyms) or outdoors
 - Choir/Band may be required to move to small groups

Cleaning

- Flat surfaces will be cleaned multiple times each day
- Students/teachers will clean desks each class period/hour
- Additional cleaning supplies provided in each classroom for frequent cleaning



Phase 4

Instruction at school and at home Students will receive in-person instruction and remote learning No school or classroom visitors

Transportation

- Assigned seats on all routes
- Hand sanitizer will be used when getting on/off each bus route
- Masks mandatory for drivers and passengers
- Windows will be open (weather permitting)
- Buses sanitized after each route
- Limited shuttle service

Food Service

- Students will be assigned a table and with social distancing
- Additional locations for lunch will be utilized (classrooms, gyms)
- Plastic silverware will be used
- Reduced meal options available

Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)

• Face mask/covering required for all students and staff (exemptions require a note from a doctor)

Health and Hygiene

- Assigned entry points to the buildings
- Temperature checks on everyone entering buildings
- Water fountains turned off Bottle fillers only.
- Hand washing/hand sanitizing every hour
- Desks wiped down when students leave the classroom



Phase 4 (cont)

Classroom/Instruction

- Students will sit in assigned seats (facing forward)
- Stable work groups will be utilized
- Individual classroom supplies (no sharing)
- Students socially distanced. No large assemblies/groupings
- Independent work only
- All extra/non-essential furniture removed from each classroom
- Classroom doors will remain open to minimize touching
- Daily logs required for remote learning

Extra and Co-curricular

- Extra-curricular activities will follow KSHSAA guidelines and local health department guidelines
- Limited spectator attendance
- Remote viewing opportunities when available
- No field trips
- Choir/Band classes in small group only

Cleaning

- Flat surfaces will be cleaned multiple times each day
- Students/teachers will clean desks each class period/hour
- Additional cleaning supplies provided in each classroom for frequent cleaning



Phase 5

Remote learning

Students will receive instruction at home (remote)

Transportation

No transportation

Food Service (if approved at the federal level)

- Meal pick-up times will be 11:30 am 1:00 pm (if approved by federal programs)
- Drive through meal pick-up at Hickok Elementary and UHS (if approved by federal programs)

Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)

Health and Hygiene

• Follow local, state and federal recommendations

Classroom/InstructionAll instruction will be provided remotely

- Teachers will make daily contact with students
- Completion of daily logs required for students/parents
- Grading and assessments continue remotely
