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PARENT PORTAL OVERVIEW

Welcome to Kite[®] Parent Portal!

Parent Portal was designed to give access to view your child's current and historical reports from assessments taken in Kite Student Portal. Kite Student Portal is used by students to complete interim predictive (fall, winter, and spring) and summative (spring) assessments developed for the Kansas Assessment Program (KAP) as well as the Dynamic Learning Maps[®] (DLM[®]) alternate assessment and Kansas English Language Proficiency Assessment (KELPA).

This user guide contains procedures to help you log in and navigate through the site to access your student's available reports.

SOFTWARE REQUIREMENTS

Parent Portal can be accessed from both desktop computers and mobile devices. You will need to use a web browser like Chrome, Firefox, Edge, or Safari on your device. You will also need the ability to view PDF documents. This functionality is built into most browsers, but may require installation of additional software, such as Adobe Acrobat Reader.


ASSESSMENT REPORTS AVAILABLE IN PARENT PORTAL

Depending on participation, your child may have current and historical assessment reports available in any of the assessment programs and subjects listed in the table below.




To log in to Kite Parent Portal, follow the processes outlined below.

- 1. Open your web browser and visit https://parentportal.kiteaai.org/
- 2. Enter your email address you previously registered with your child's school district in the Email Address field.
- 3. Click Get Started!
- 4. An email will be sent from the Kite Service Desk to the registered email address with a temporary access code.

ACCESS CODES


All access codes used to enter the site are randomly generated and are valid for 24 hours. You can use the same access code multiple times within a 24-hour period to enter Parent Portal. If you wish log in again after that period, a new access code will be emailed to you.

If you do not receive an email, please check your junk or spam folder. If you did not receive or forget your access code, click the **Resend Access Code** button to request a new code.

Note: Parent Portal provides assessment reports for KAP assessments, the KELPA assessment, and the Dynamic Learning Maps[®] (DLM[®]) alternate assessment. If your child participated in more than one assessment, you will see report details for each assessment on the homepage.




NAVIGATION MENU AND USER OPTIONS

- 2. Assessment Description: A brief description of the assessment program shown.
- 3. Report Subject: The specific report subject in the table below.
- 4. **Report Table**: Student and report data, including the report year, school, grade level, and the downloadable report PDF.
- 5. **Report PDF:** Click the icon to download a PDF of your child's report.

SORT AND FILTER RESULTS

Data in all tables can be sorted and filtered to tailor results based on your needs. Click anywhere in the desired column header to sort the data from A-Z. Click again to reverse the sort from Z-A.

REPORT WALKTHROUGH

2021 KAP Summative score reports in all subjects include a built-in score report walkthrough. This tool explains key elements of the score report. As sections are explained, a green box will appear around the relevant section. Use the buttons to the left of the score report to control the report walkthrough.

	1. Play button – click to begin audio playback
2	Stop button – click to stop audio playback
+ 3	3. Download button – click to download report
8 4	4. Close button – click to close window and return to Report page.

Note: Selecting Stop will return the audio to the start.
