#### 2. Service Above Self:

Summarize your service to others, above and beyond that which is required in class.

#### 3. Vocation Preparation:

Summarize how you have prepared to succeed.

- Leadership Activities
- Scholarship (course selection, ACT score, grade point)

### 4. Communication Skills:

How you look, speak and write are a reflection of your values and standards. Your written application and interview will be used to evaluate these skills.

#### 5. Career or Vocational Choice:


What is your field of study? Why did you select this area? What are your long term goals in this particular field?


